A Note From Bryan. . . Exodus 2:25

Exodus 2:25 states that God, "looked upon the children of Israel and God acknowledged them." Those are two very powerful thoughts coupled with those from verse 24 that says God heard the people's cries to Him and remembered His covenant. God never forgot His covenant, really. Besides that, it is an important application to make that God always looks upon or is able to see and acknowledge His people.

Exodus chapters three and four go about telling us how it was that God acknowledged His people. What we finally understand is that God acknowledged His people by giving them the leadership they needed. Throughout Exodus chapters three and four we read about Moses' experience witnessing this burning, but not consumed, bush "in the back of the desert."

Often times we study Moses' excuses because we, like Moses, are apt to make excuses when it comes to heeding God's call and leading God's people in an acceptable way. However, we must also observe the importance of God's reassurance through this exercise with Moses. Exodus 3:6 tells us that this was so amazing Moses hid his face and the Lord called from the bush for Moses to take off His sandals because he was on holy ground. In verse 10 the Lord said, "Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt."

Every question Moses had, God reassuringly answered. Every weakness Moses admitted, God reassured with an answer to provide. Every time Moses tried to refuse, God was there with reassuring support. We do well to remember that we serve the same God who lovingly reassures us that He hears, remembers, sees, and will acknowledge us when we cry out.
