### A Note From Bryan. . . . Happy New Year!

Good Sunday Morning and welcome to this first Sunday of 2010. I hope that you have had a great holiday and that you are ready to start the New Year off right. You have already made a good decision in being with us this morning. We appreciate your presence this morning and look forward to a happy and healthy New Year.

This morning I want to call your attention to a great passage of Scripture; one you may already know well and love. This is a passage that you may have even seen written over Tim Tebow's eye black, Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Although I'm not a Gator's fan and not necessarily a Tebow fan I appreciate the way he would paint a verse on his face before the games. I believe it was a good example to those young people who admired him.

This verse is one that I am sure you have looked to for strength and encouragement in times when you have needed it the most. It may be the one verse you are familiar with that you can go to in a time of need and find a little bit of strength to face your anxieties. There are a number of things that the context tells us we can do with Christ as our strength. We can endure our struggles, we can develop a humble attitude, we can come to know Christ in a greater way, and we can derive a peace not known by others in the world. I'm sure you can share your personal stories of other ways that you have been able to apply this in your own life.

As we begin a New Year I thought it would be encouraging to look at this passage and all the great things we can do in the year to come realizing that it is Christ in us that gives us the strength to carry on and overcome our own self-imposed limitations. I believe we can gain the encouragement from this passage to overcome the limitations that others often impose upon us as well. I pray that God will richly bless you in the days ahead.
