A Note From Bryan... Making the Most of the New Year

Happy New Year! Welcome to our first Lord's Day of the New Year. This morning I will present a few ideas for making the most of 2009. One of the thoughts that I have gleaned from motivational literature is the idea that we need to take every experience of years gone by, good and bad, and pour them into the next year of life. I am going to use the bulletin article today a little differently. Instead of a page of text I am printing a basic outline of today's lesson with space for you to include your own notes. Here are a few ways to make the most of 2009 (adapted from Cherokee Business, 2008 by Julianne Rivera).

1. Identify and celebrate the victories, 1 John 5:4, 5.
2. Identify, admit, and learn from your mistakes, 1 John 1:5-10.
3. Write your own personal mission statement and spend the next year refining that vision, Luke 19:10.
4. Focus on ways to improve, 2 Timothy 2:15.
5. Share your plans with someone you trust, Nehemiah 2:12.
6. Surround yourself with the best people; those who can help you achieve your goals, 1 Chronicles 11:20; Mark 3:13-19.
