A Note From Bryan. . . Numbers

Numbers figure prominently in the Bible from cover to cover. Genesis unfolds in the very first seven day period. Noah was given exact measurements for building an ark to save himself and his family (eight people in all, 1 Peter 3:20) and he was told exactly how many of each animal, clean and unclean, were to be put in the ark to save. Of course, we know how many days and nights it rained, how deep the water was that covered the earth and how many days the family and the animals stayed on the ark. Were all these numbers simply interesting to include, or was there something more to these exact numbers?

Reading through Exodus, Moses' age at each stage of his life and leadership are mentioned. We are told how many Israelites escape Egyptian bondage. We know the dimensions of the tabernacle, how many commandments Moses was given on Sinai, and how long Moses stayed on Sinai before coming down to deliver God's commandments. Although we may not completely understand the true significance of each number, we can be certain that the numbers in Scripture are not random happenstance, and they are not included to simply create interesting reading.

When genealogies are mentioned in the Scripture, we are told specific ages of each father, in some cases the number of children each had. In other cases, such as the genealogical information given of Jesus by Matthew, is mentioned the number of generations between Abraham and David, etc (Matthew 1:17). The numbers found in the Bible are really fascinating when you consider them. Often times, I will skip over genealogies and census data, but there is much to learn from the numbers in Scripture, and these are worthy of our time to read and study. Today, I want to spend our time of study together looking at the significance of a single number: 40. I hope you enjoy and benefit from this interesting study.
