A Note From Bryan. . . Commitment

Commitment seems like such an intimidating word. I hear many times from single women, comments about men who are "afraid of commitment." I have discussed at length, in sermon, the need and the difficulty of gaining commitment from Christians. Lately, there have been some events that have given me a different perspective on the idea of commitment. In short form, the idea is that it really isn't all that hard to secure commitment to works, to ministries, or to people that others truly care about.

Last year over sixty people turned out for the "Be the Match" run. Individuals made commitments of time and personal funds on a cold day to run, walk, or crawl to benefit Margaret Mason and others with bone marrow diseases. The commitment of time and funds was not so hard to secure because people cared both for Margaret and for the cause. It was a beautiful illustration of how people will make great sacrifices and commit to the things they care about the most.

For the last two years, I have asked our eldership, and other elderships in the area, a simple question: what is/are the greatest challenges you face as an eldership. Without hesitation, the answer from all of them was the same, even if they worded their responses differently. All the elderships I have asked have responded that their number one, greatest challenge as an eldership is getting every Christian involved and motivated in doing the Lord's work.

What could possibly be more important than your soul? In Mark 8:36, 37, Jesus essentially said that there is nothing more precious than your soul. The value of your eternal soul trumps every other relationship in your life. Your soul is more important than any investment you've ever made and more important than anything you own, that you work hard to keep. Since your soul is the most important thing in your life, why wouldn't you commit to those things necessary to secure your soul and grow your soul closer to the savior? As we embark on this theme of recommitting ourselves to Christ, consider those things you might do to be recommitted to His cause in this world.
