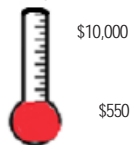

FAITHFUL IN SPITE OF TRAGEDIES

There Joseph is back in the pit once again! This time he is not in a pit of earth, he is in a prison. Surely he felt like his star was on the rise; now, it looks like those dreams will never be fulfilled. Many people would have given up and quit had they found themselves in the same situation. Not Joseph! He remained faithful in spite of everything life threw at him.

How was this possible? Genesis 39:21 says, "The Lord was with Joseph." That verse also says that God "showed him mercy". Verse 23 tells us again that "the Lord was with him". It also says, "and that which he did, the Lord made it to prosper".

You see, Joseph was faithful to the Lord regardless of where he was; and regardless of where he was, the Lord was faithful to Joseph.
