A Note From Bryan. . . What Jesus had to say about "sinners"

What Jesus had to say about "sinners" directly affects you and me. What is said about Jesus' attitude toward sinners should reassure us each day. Paul wrote in 1 Timothy 1:15, "This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief." Most Christians today have a high esteem for the apostle Paul. Paul considered himself to be the chief of sinners, what does that make me?

Admitting fault is a hard thing for us to do most of the time. Owning our sins and confessing them is too embarrassing. We'd rather keep things quiet; between us and God as much as possible. We may not confess our faults and trespasses to one another as we ought because of that fear of being found out but it ought to be a part of our daily prayers. Your fellow Christians may not know what's going on in your life but Christ knows and He came to save us.

When we open the Scriptures we find that Jesus loved sinners and associated with them which turned the self-righteous Pharisees against Him. Jesus association with sinners was never by joining them in their sin. On the contrary, we also find that sinners were drawn to Jesus. Wherever Jesus went and taught sinful people hungry for His message came in droves. Jesus' whole purpose on this earth was to turn sinners to God and to convince them of a better way of life that would give them everlasting peace. Jesus called sinners to repentance. What more can we do?

The irony of the whole thing is that Jesus came for the purpose of saving sinners, the very ones who would betray Him! Yet, He came anyway. He offered us salvation, anyway. This fact helps us better understand the Scriptures and their importance in our lives. When Jesus finished His prayers in Gethsemane (Matthew 26:45; Mark 14:41) He said, "The hour has come; behold, the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners." I'm thankful that Jesus came into this world to save sinners. I'm thankful that this fact is a faithful saying worthy of all acceptance!
