### The Eldership

Several of you commented recently that you appreciated the sermon outline printed in the space for the article to help you make notes on the sermon. This week I will try that again. In Acts 14:23 Luke recounted how Paul and Barnabas established elders in every one of their new church plants in Asia Minor. When looking at the Bible to establish an eldership it is important to look at the terms used to describe these men and their work. The New Testament talks about elders using three different terms.

1. The Presbyter or "Old Man."
  - a. Used exclusively in the Old Testament.
  - b. Old does not mean useless!
2. The Bishop or "Overseer."
  - a. Confused and abused.
  - b. Illustrated by what shepherds do...
  - c. Oversee the spiritual guidance of the flock.
3. The Pastor or "Shepherd."
  - a. Frequent Bible imagery.
  - b. Role near and dear to God's heart.
  - c. Specific work.

Consider these words and ideas carefully.
