A teacher picked up a single stick and said to his students "break the stick into pieces", which each easily did. Then he took three sticks and bound them together into a bundle. "Now try to break them!" he told them. Not even the strongest one could do it. "That," he pointed out, "is the difference between working separately and working together as one." The wise man, Solomon, said (Ecclesiastes 4:12) "A threefold cord is not likely broken."

What has this to do with us in the church today? Religion is derived from the old Latin religio. It means "to bind together." That is the purpose of our congregation at Woodstock — to bind people together in Christ — not to work alone, separate or develop cliques and factions. Our purpose is to work together as one and as Christ desires (John 17:21).

Do each of us want happiness? Do we want satisfaction? Do we desire contentment and blessings? We all do. The surest source of all these is in Christ as members united as one in his spiritual body. We all want our families to enjoy these things with us. We should also want our neighbors and acquaintances to enjoy these things with us. We, therefore should appeal to them out of love for God and man to become united as Christians and members with us in the one Body of Christ (Ephesians 4:4); a task that He has assigned to each who would claim Him as Lord (Mark 16:15, Acts 8:4)! We must not fail Him for any reason.

One lesson we need to always remember is the joy that comes from working together as Christians with common cause. It is the greatest joy, the epitome of satisfaction, the ultimate contentment to know the Lord will say to us, "Well done." The blessings from the Lord come to us as we surrender our wills to his and know that the work he asks us to do is never a burden. "For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous" (1 John 5:3).

To become a Christian is required and good, but becoming a Christian who is bound to others is also necessary. So, think of sticks, cords, and bundles, and think of the task before us, and then be a part bound together with love for the whole congregation and its work. You'll always be glad you did!
