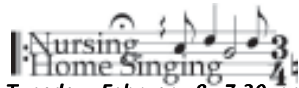

A Note From Bryan . . . Get to Know Jesus

We talk a lot about fellowship, encouragement, and family when we are together as a body. We all know the importance of relationships in our physical families and with our church family as well. There are people we know by acquaintance and people we know intimately and every other relationship in between. There are people we want to know and we have the power to limit how much can be known about us individually.

Sometimes we are shocked by how much information exists about us on the internet. We are also shocked at what people choose to reveal about themselves and their activities on blogs, websites and in social media. Forming and building relationships takes great time and great care wandering the maze of when people will "friend" you and how much they will reveal of themselves to you. If you try too hard to get to know someone often times they will reject you or try to put you off and close themselves off until they trust you enough to let you into their lives. Jesus had this same sort of experience in His day-think John 4 and the woman at the well. Until she believed that He was the Messiah she was unwilling to open up to Him.

When you consider how relationships work in the real world consider what God has revealed about Himself through Jesus Christ. God has revealed all that we need to know in order to come to Him and trust Him with all that's on our mind and in our lives good and bad. According to the Scriptures He knows it already (Psalm 139; Hebrews 4:12, 13). Yet He has invited us into a relationship where we are loved and safe. This morning we are going to look at the dichotomy of opinion about Jesus in His own day and ours. We are also going to consider the larger fact that all men have an opportunity to come to Him and know Him, Matthew 11:28-30.
