### A Note From Bryan. . . Seeking Jesus

There is a little song that children sing about a wee little man who climbed up in a Sycamore tree to see Jesus. I like the way these songs teach our children. I like the fact that little kids will sit in the audience today and be able to understand that the sermon is about that song they sing in Bible class. But there is so much more to that little song and the story of that little man that adults can appreciate too.

There are three things about the account of Zacchaeus in Luke 19:1-10 that I will share with you today. These three things from a single event, from a single day in Zacchaeus' life will enrich our own Christian lives. Zacchaeus, we are told, was small in stature, he was rich, and he was a chief tax collector. This adds up to mean that he was hated by the people around him. These things probably isolated Zacchaeus too. Of all the people in that crowd that day Jesus called out this little "weasel."

Zacchaeus, as we've always been taught, climbed up in that Sycamore tree because he wanted to see who this Jesus was; he was seeking Jesus, he was interested in finding out about Jesus. Have you been so interested? He didn't let his stature or his reputation or what people thought of him hold him back from his search for Jesus. What sorts of things have been holding you back?

Zacchaeus' ethics underwent an immediate transformation (Luke 19:8). When Jesus called him out he made things right, immediately. When Zacchaeus realized that Jesus cared for Him that fact changed his life. If you could be assured that Jesus cares for you, what would you change?

You notice, as you read Luke 19:1-10, that from Jesus' own mouth, He states that His purpose was to seek and save the lost. Jesus told Zacchaeus that He was going to stay with Him. When we truly seek Jesus and allow Him into our lives, we begin to understand that He is seeking us and that His desire is to save us. We also notice that when Jesus comes into our lives, He is coming to stay. Some of Jesus' last words to us were, Revelation 3:20-21 "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne."

Will today be the day that Jesus came into your life and changed it for the better?
