A Note From Bryan . . . Stay the Course

The way you discipline your children largely grows from what you learned from your parents, who learned child discipline from their parents. However, you may have found things that work better and suit you better that you practice with your children. You might choose disciplinary measures that are less physical than your parents or grandparents used. You may have also learned to manage your finances from your parents and you may have found a better way of handling all things financial since you became a responsible adult. Each generation depends on the generations before for a part of their learning. Each successive generation makes its own set of mistakes while trying to learn from the mistakes of the past, or so we would hope.

In the fifth chapter of Deuteronomy, Moses had gathered this new generation, and began to share with them the Ten Commandments. Their response was: "tell us all that the Lord our God says to you, and we will hear and do it", Deuteronomy 5:27. God knew that their intentions were feeble, He said, "Oh that they had such a heart in them that they would fear Me and always keep all My commandments, that it might be well with them and their children forever!" It is easy to be committed when things are fresh and new, but when the going gets tough, it is commitment that fuels us to the next phase of spiritual growth. God knew that human nature was powerful straight out of the gate but as time wears on we're not much for stamina. God told Moses to tell this new generation to stay the course; not to deviate to the right or to the left. These are meaningful words for today. We can get too far right or left and get off course. To be committed to the cause of Christ in this world, we must stay the course.
