Reg (& Kathy) has gone out of his way to be a help in various areas to make this work more of a joy—and easier on all of us. From getting softball equipment for Kyle's kids to arranging airline tickets (checking on seating, boarding passes, etc.) to hauling stuff to and from India for the good of the work—and on and on—we are truly blessed to have Reg & Kathy in the positions they fill to assist us.

Third—not many churches are willing to allow their preacher to be gone, even for a mission trip.
