### WHERE DO WE GO WHEN WE DIE?

Very often Bumper Stickers are displayed in order to publicly express an opinion or perhaps to indicate support of a philosophical or a religious doctrinal position. Almost daily one can see a Bumper Sticker with the following theological question: "If you were to die today, where would your soul be tomorrow, Heaven or Hell?" There is little doubt that the intent of this display is to cause people to turn to Jesus Christ while they have time and opportunity in this life to do that. Though the personal intent of the message is admirable, there is, nonetheless, a misuse and misapplication of Scripture designed to encourage people to make a positive change in their lives. Though man's intent in doing this may be based in Scripture, the method or action of doing it is not, but rather is based on a false premise caused by not handling the Word of God correctly!

When a person dies, the spirit does not go to Heaven or Hell, nor to the grave as some would suppose! It goes by God's direction to Hades (one of the words translated as "hell" in the King James Bible), which denotes the "place of all disembodied spirits." This is where Lazarus and the rich man of Luke sixteen went upon their deaths. This is also where Christ and the "thief on the cross" went when they died. Christ did not ascend to the Father and heaven until forty days after His resurrection from Paradise, i.e., the Hadean World- John 17:20 & Acts 1:3. In Acts 2:34, we learn that David is still not ascended into the heavens, because he, too, remains in Hades). Lazarus was carried by angels into that part of Hades referred to as Paradise or Abraham's bosom, while the rich man awoke in that part of Hades referred to as a place of torments! Each of these will remain where they are until the general resurrection of the dead (John 5:28-29) which occurs at the second coming of the Lord. The same is true of David and the "thief on the cross." In the resurrection, their spirits (and the spirits of all the dead) will leave the Hadean world and rejoin their changed bodies (I Corinthians 15:51) to stand before Christ in judgment (2 Corinthians 5:10). The righteous (those obedient to Christ) will then go to Heaven (Matthew 25:24). The unrighteous (the disobedient) shall then be cast into Hell, the lake of eternal fire and brimstone (Matthew 25:41), along with death and Hades (Revelation 20:14) that includes the two waiting places for the second coming, (Paradise) and (Tartarus, 2 Peter 2:4), because there will be no more need for death and the waiting places!

Numerous false teachings are espoused relative to what happens after this life! One's personal intent may be good, but the support of that intent is not to be founded in Scriptural error, but in the truth only by which man is to be sanctified (John 17:17)!
