A Note From Bryan . . . Giving

Paul had a way with words and a way with people. Paul, we know was a powerful evangelist or at least an energetic church planter from his major journeys throughout Asia Minor. At the same time there were those who doubted Paul's apostleship. 2 Corinthians was a means of reestablishing his credibility with that congregation after someone had apparently tried to lead them away. Paul was also criticized as being a big talker in his writing but having a weak and ineffectual physical presence and speech (2 Corinthians 10:8-10).

In Acts 17 while walking down an unnamed street of Athens, Greece the idolatry that ensconced the city provoked Paul's spirit (v. 16). But rather than condemn the Athenians with "fire and brimstone" he met them where they were by introducing them to "The Unknown God" proclaiming Him to be the one and only God who gives breath, life, and movement to men (v. 28).

In this same spirit Paul taught the grace of giving in 2 Corinthians chapters eight and nine. Many commentators have dubbed these chapters some of the best biblical teaching on the principles of giving. You will notice that he began with a compliment in 2 Corinthians 8:1-5 holding up the Macedonians as great examples of stewardship both of themselves and of their financial means as meager as they were.

Last week this congregation was praised for the stewardship that exists here: that even though we have faced tremendous fiscal and economic odds you have come through with generosity. Let me echo those thoughts from brother Rick and the spirit in which Paul spoke of the Macedonians by saying thank you for being givers both of yourselves and of your means in such hard economic times. At no point have we diminished our pantry that you have not responded by filling it from your kind hearts and generous spirits. At no time have we faced a financial need that you have not responded with open generosity to provide what is lacking. The Lord truly provides and you, as His children, always provide generously from your means and like the Macedonians you have brought your gifts many times going beyond your ability.
