A Note From Bryan. . . The Last Word

Do you ever insist on getting the last word? No matter what arguments you may win in this life, God is going to have the last word in the judgment. As a matter of fact you could say that He has already had the last word. The Bible is the last will and testament of the Father in heaven and in Jesus He has shared His last revelation or His last word with us.

The book of Hebrews is a book that has something of a mysterious cast to it. We do not know conclusively who wrote the book of Hebrews. Scholars all have their opinions based on this line of evidence or that line of evidence. There is speculation based upon who is most likely to have written because of the Greek and because of how the concepts are worded. We also do not know conclusively to whom it was written. Yet, none of these mysteries should shake our faith in the inspiration of Hebrews or its place in the canon of Scripture.

The book of Hebrews was inspired by God and we can believe in that. Regardless of who wrote it or to whom it was written great truths are contained in its pages and we know what those truths are. We know that it was written to Christians with Jewish backgrounds and who were in danger of falling away due to apathy. They were not growing spiritually and they were, in some cases, going back to living according to law and Jewish traditions as opposed to living a free life in Christ.

Hebrews emphasizes the superiority of Christ over the prophets, Moses, the angels and so on. Hebrews is filled with encouragement to stay faithful but it also contains some stern warnings for those who are in danger of falling away. Today we will look at Hebrews 1:1-4 and Jesus' superiority over the prophets and a comparison of how God worked in times past and how He is working today.
