### A Note From Bryan... How To Treat Elders

One of the most valuable principles we learn in life is how to treat other people. When we learn to encourage others we find them encouraging us in return. Likewise if we learn to be harsh, critical, and discouraging, that is what we receive in turn; it's the law of sowing and reaping. In Matthew 7:16 Jesus asked a rhetorical question, "Do men gather grapes from thorn bushes or figs from thistles?" The answer is obvious. If we want a healthy, thriving congregation we have to cultivate it by the way we treat one another.

- Christians are obliged to recognize their elders and esteem them, 1 Thessalonians 5:12, 13.
  - Know them.
  - Esteem them for their work
- Christians are obliged to give their elders the honor they deserve, 1 Timothy 5:17-19.
  - Those who rule well
  - Elders compensation
  - Do justice to them
- Christians are obliged to submit themselves to their local body of elders, 1 Peter 5:5.

I hope this series has been helpful for you and opened up your mind to more than just a list of "qualifications." The qualifications are important but there is so much more our elders need in order for their work among us to be a joy rather than grief. Among those things is each one of us learning how we should treat them as our elders but also as our brothers in Christ.
