Ladies, you are invited to a baby shower for Beth Wallace. Beth is expecting a girl. She is not registered and mainly needs diapers and wipes.

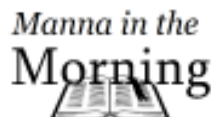

**INDIA UPDATE: RON CLAYTON LETTER OF APPRECIATION, PART 2**
