Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

SCRIPTURAL OBEDIENCE

Is defined as: Compliance with someone's wishes or orders or acknowledgment of their authority; submission to a law or rule.

The apostle Paul, in Romans 1:5 uses the phrase "obedience to the faith", i.e., the obedience to which faith leads and the obedience which perfects or completes faith. It is only a perfected or completed faith that justifies and saves. What, then, is perfected or completed faith" that justifies? We find the answer in James 2:21-22, "Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect (complete).

May I suggest that saving faith is clearly a faith that is perfected and completed by the things that we do in response to the laws and rule of our Authority Figure; God? And may I further suggest that the required response that demonstrates and assures that our personal faith is, indeed, 'saving faith' must be a total commitment and surrendering response to all of the laws and rule of our authority figure? Well, what does that mean? It simply means that 'saving faith' demands living for Christ every day of every week; not simply a refraining from "major" sin, while paying a weekly visit to the Sunday morning services.

Justification comes through the things we do; not by faith only (James 2:24); works, not of righteousness (Titus 3:5), yet works of obedience, which when coupled with our faith, result in a faith that justifies and saves! Faith without works; without total commitment, is dead (James 2:26). The death referred to by James is a spiritual death; a death that comes from disobedience to the laws and rule of our Authority Figure! When that death occurs, one is then separated from God, lost and undone (Isaiah 59:1-2).

Our Lord set a surrendering example for us when "He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross' (Philippians 2:8). He completely surrendered to the will of His Authority Figure. We can do no less, even unto death, if we would receive the crown of life (Revelation 2:10).
