A Note From Bryan. . . Power to Choose

Please do not misunderstand the point of this lesson. When Jesus was praying in the garden of Gethsemane, He demonstrated the power of choice. I do not think Jesus would have chosen anything else than to do what He did, and I do not believe Jesus had another option in mind. Nowhere does the text indicate anything of the sort. However, when you read Luke 22:39-46 you hear Jesus ask for "this cup to pass", but only if it was the will of God.

One overarching truth of any biblical narrative is that there is more to most accounts than meets the eye. The things recorded in the Bible didn't just happen, they happened for a reason. Jesus didn't just teach and perform miracles, everything Jesus said and did had a greater purpose. We must read and reflect upon the narratives of Jesus' life in order to understand what they are teaching us. The more we read them over the course of our lives, the more the deeper truths unfold for us.

Jesus' prayer in the garden demonstrates for us that we have within us the power to choose God's will over our own will, even when we know it might be painful. Jesus shows us what an amazing capacity we have for committing to the purposes of God and opening ourselves up to God's guidance in our lives. Through practice and discipline, we can turn our lives over to God and seek His will through prayer and study and dedication.

Jesus knew the cost of doing God's will so completely. For Him it was to endure the abuse and execution of the cross. You and I have the power within us to choose God's will when it hurts, when we recognize the cost. We can seek God's will through prayer. What will you choose?
