Several congregations from the area will join with our local Spanish congregation for worship, lunch and fellowship in our building today.

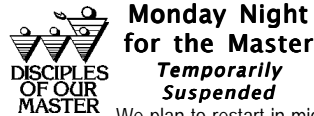

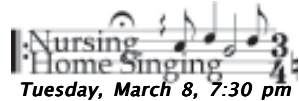
