Today, March 7, 4 pm

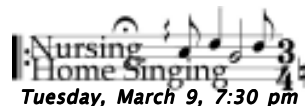

### A Note From Bryan. . . Human and Divine

It can be difficult for us to understand exactly how Jesus could be both human and divine. Try explaining this to elementary school children as a way to wrap your mind around it. The first chapter of the gospel of John opens by telling us that in the beginning was the divine Word and verse fourteen then says that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. This morning I am going to delve into the realm of Jesus' humanity from Hebrews 2 and other supporting passages.

One of the basic truths of Scripture; of salvation, even, is that we must believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. He said so Himself in John 8:24. At the same time, the Bible tells us that the young virgin Mary was with child by the Holy Spirit, Luke 1:35. When Jesus took on flesh and blood He arrived in this world as a baby born in a stable. Luke 2:52 tells us that He grew up, and grew strong, like most other children, but once He became a man, He was baptized by John in the Jordan River, and there began His ministry in this world.

We read so many passages that talk about Jesus experiencing all the same things we humans experience, temptations (Luke 4), hunger, thirst, fatigue. There was no doubt that Jesus was truly a man and that He was truly divine. Paul wrote in Philippians 2 that Jesus did this as an example for us. Jesus was a king in heaven and left that throne of glory to become like us, and as one of us, He took the lowly station of a servant. Jesus said in Mark 10:45, "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

The significance of Jesus' humanity is that it is a demonstration of what is humanly possible in service to God. We have access to the divine strength of our Lord and savior and we have an amazing human capacity to carry out the will of God.
