### A Note From Bryan... Responding to the gospel

What is the appropriate response to the preaching of the gospel? This isn't meant to be a trick question. There are dozens of ways to appropriately respond to the message of the gospel. First and foremost, the response should be to the truth and not to the personality of the one delivering the message and the beneficiary should always be the one responding to the message. Second, the only inappropriate response worthy of mentioning is no response at all; to be indifferent and do nothing at all.

It is interesting, all the different perspectives that come from any one audience. From one simple message come multiple responses. There is really no way to gauge how one message is going to be received by many. This demonstrates the power of truth and the weak link of communication. You never know how a crowd is going to react to a sermon and there is really no way to anticipate what might come from the minds of the hearers.

Even Jesus had trouble communicating. There was no way He could reach 100% of His audience. There was always someone who didn't get it and it was, at times, even those closest to Him. When Jesus finished the Sermon on the Mount, the crowds couldn't get enough; they just kept right on following Him. Although Jesus said little or nothing about healing in the sermon, it began and ended with people wanting to be healed.

Jesus is the best preacher that has ever spoken God's word. He was a willing healer, not afraid to reach out and touch those who had been isolated by disease. He was willing to take charge of situations that would've turned others away. Jesus was at times amazed by the faith of the most unlikely people. This morning we are going to look at Matthew chapter 8 and find out how people reacted to Jesus' sermon.

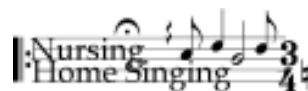
