Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

CAN SALVATION ONCE GAINED BE LOST?

From Revelation 2:10 we learn that in order to receive the crown of life, we must be faithful until death! If one, then, is not faithful unto death, but is like the servant of Matthew 25:14-30 who did no "works," but rather hid his talents, then it would be the case that he would receive the same judgment that fell to that "wicked and slothful servant (Matthew 25:26), i.e., "Cast the unprofitable servant into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth." In Matthew 25, Jesus is giving examples of the conduct He expects of His servants in the kingdom of heaven or His church (Matthew 25:1; Matthew 25:14). It is worthy of note that the one-talent servant in His kingdom was cast into outer darkness, i.e., the one-talent man had been accepted as a servant in His Kingdom, but was subsequently lost in hell which brings us to, and answers, the question, "Can I lose my salvation?" Obviously, the answer is yes! Not only does Matthew 25:14-30 teach that one saved can subsequently be lost, but clearly the following passages teach the same: Matthew 7:19; Matthew 13:41-42; Luke 8:4-15; John 15:2-6; I Corinthians 8:11; I Corinthians 9:27; I Corinthians 10:12; I Corinthians 15:2; II Corinthians 6:1; Galatians 5:4; Galatians 6:7-9; Colossians 1:23; I Timothy 4:1-3; Hebrews 3:12; Hebrews 6:4-6; Hebrews 10:26-29; James 5:19-20; II Peter 1: 1-10; II Peter 2:20-22; Revelation 3:16, to name just a few!

The errant notion of "once saved, always saved" does not find its beginning with John Calvin or any other man, though it has been perpetuated by man! The source of this statement and all sin is found in Satan who first implied and proclaimed this sinful doctrine when he wrested the Word of God by saying, "You will not surely die"! God had said to Adam, 'reject Me and My words, and in the day you do "You will surely die", i.e., 'you will be separated from Me! Satan said, "Adam, just forget what God said, you're saved and you're going to remain saved no matter what He said, or no matter what you do or what you don't do!"
