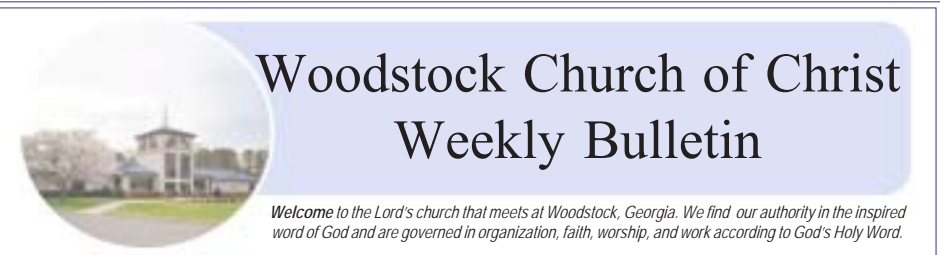

It seems like not a year passes by that I do not hear Christians say that the Bible is in harmony with Science. Unfortunately, this seemingly innocent phrase is fully loaded with post-modernistic overtones. People today have developed a great urgency to unify the scripture to science so as not to be perceived as unlearned by the world. It is true that science can tell us many things about the order and operation of the Universe. But do not confuse science with "Scientism." Scientism, not unlike the Devil transforming himself into an Angel of light, prevails in the world by pretending to be something it is not. Scientism is a deep rooted self-faith, i.e. Humanism. It does not follow the scientific method, and knows that its theories cannot be proved in simple laboratory experiments. Examples of Scientism include an expanding universe (big-bang), old age theories, and man-made climate change. These theories are wrought with presumption which requires a blind faith of the wielder. As was detailed in a previous article, the big bang is based upon nothing more than speculative belief of an expanding Universe. The scientific award winning and well-known astrophysicist, Halton Arp, challenged the interpretation of the cosmological redshift. Redshift is a shift in energy of light as it travels from the distant parts of the galaxy back to us on Earth. It is assumed this phenomenon is solely due to the Doppler Effect from which Scientism derives large universal distances, and thus an old age. The Doppler Effect is the phenomenon you observe when the sound waves from a train's horn seem higher pitch when the horn is moving towards you, and lower pitch when moving away. Arp tabulated many stellar light sources via the Hubble telescope. He proved the Doppler only redshift to be highly questionable, a conjecture still debated by Scientism. Why debate? Because then there is no longer a need for a Big-Bang, blackholes, nor dark matter. Arp was excommunicated from his field of science in America because he showed contradictory data and questioned the "consensus of scientists." Arp, who was an Atheist and moved to Germany, said before his death,

"I gloomily came to the ironic conclusion that if you take a highly intelligent person and give them the best possible, elite education, then you will most likely wind up with an academic who is completely impervious to reality."

As a consequence of Arp's work, the stars you see in the sky may be a lot closer to you than Scientism is willing to admit. This also leads to a much younger Universe, a thought that is reprehensible to Scientism.

A prime example of good science is found in the recent discovery surrounding Quasars. Quasars are light generators that are found all throughout the Universe. Quasars have been found to be surrounded by gigantic amounts of water vapor. The amount of water found around one Quasar was 140 trillion times that of all the water found in the Earth's oceans [NASA 2011]. Houston we have lift-off. Haven't we read in God's word,

"And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so." Genesis 1:6-7

"And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years. And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also." Genesis 1:14-16

The original primordial bath of water was divided and large amounts went into the firmament of the heaven where the stars were formed. For you see my friends, God said it was water and it was so. Day means day and water means water! Don't be fooled with the vain philosophies of the world. Dare to stand like Joshua!
