A Note From the Elders . . . Choices

We make choices every day. We make decisions from the moment we wake until our eyes become heavy with sleep. Some choices are pretty simple and some choices are made for us. Many aspects of our life are out of our control and sometimes give up control completely, deciding to simply "go with the flow". As we make choices during our day, many factors affect each decision point. Something may look like fun but if the fear of injury is stronger than the desire for pleasure or growth, we won't do it. Decisions like this are based on training and experience and both of these are things we continue to build on every day of our lives. With no outside influence, we will usually make choices that will not harm us, but that also means we will often take a path that will not challenge us to grow. We choose to remain "safe" where we are.

Our spiritual life is no different. When we are "young" in the Lord, we see no danger in the challenges of sharing our faith and taking a stand for our beliefs. As we do that, we often feel the sharp pain of ridicule. Jesus tells us in John 17 what we can expect when we stand up for the Lord. *"I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.* When we know of something that goes against God's will, we make a choice to accept or reject it. The choice may be complicated by cultural pressure or legal requirements. The opinions of our friends and coworkers will also come into play, but we must still make a choice: pain or safety.

God loves every one of us. He created us, He provides for our physical needs, and He provides a way for us to live forever with Him. He expects us to love Him and to love each other in the same way. But like God, we must hate sin. We cannot accept the sins of men under the pretense that God's love allows Him to overlook those sins. Sin can never be overlooked but it can be forgiven through the grace of Jesus when we accept His salvation and strive to do His will. We are obligated by our love for God to teach His ways to everyone with kindness and respect and then continue to be examples of God's perfect love. Pray daily for His guidance and strength as we strive to reflect His love.
