DO YOU STILL BELIEVE IN THE BIBLE? PART 2

March 19, 2017

Continuing on with our thoughts from last week, we saw the importance of water in creation. Water from that original primordial pool was divided and some remained on Earth and much was pushed out into the heavens. Many scientists will tell you that billions of years elapsed while the universe was formed. What Scientism will not tell you is the fact that the universe, on macro-scale, is not dominated by gravity as they claim. Comparing the gravitational and electromagnetic force (EMF) between a bound electron and proton system (hydrogen) it can be shown the EMF is 1039 times larger than gravity. Yes, that is a 1 followed by 39 zeros! Only when God brought large amounts of neutralized mass together did the gravitational forces dominate resulting in the planets revolving around stars. Even on the Sun, the EMF surface dominates causing coronal mass ejections (CMEs) of solar plasma (charged particles) that stream towards Earth (results in the Northern Lights we see). Some "heretical" scientists have put forth an entirely new plasma-based theory of the universe. It explains measured data far better than the Big-Bang model, predicting phenomena that were discovered many years later. Scientism will not allow such theories to be published in their journals, much less on the front of Time magazine. So you might ask what does this have to do with Genesis 1 and why I am in a science class right now? Two plasma science experiments come to mind ...

The first experiment involved two copper wires. They were placed in a vacuum chamber and then extremely large electrical currents of opposite direction were induced down the wires. The wires immediately vaporized into copper plasma. The EMFs caused the two plasma streams to interact, resulting in structures of ionized gas that highly resembled small galaxies. This simple experiment didn't explain every minute detail we see in the cosmos, but it explained 100 fold more than Big-Bang models. In fact, it explains exactly why the heavy element planets (dirt/rock) exist closer to stars, and the gaseous planets are further out (e.g. Jupiter).

The second experiment involved the creation of a plasma beam. A highly ionized particle beam, made up of the element 187Re (Rhenium), was accelerated to very high speeds which gave it a particle temperature (energy) of 100's millions degrees F. Rhenium is known to decay to 187Os (Osmium) with a half-life of 42 billion years in its current non-ionized state. The measured levels of Osmium indicated that the half-life had been reduced by factor of one billion. Thus, during the formation of the universe when waters were very energetic and hot, the particle production and decay rates were faster by a factor of a billion. Decay rates of elements are not time keepers and meaningless for dating methods in cooled states. Furthermore, the stars did not generate the materials needed to form the planets, they are the "left-overs" from the original bowl of ingredients from day one, used for heating and keeping time/seasons. This is why you read they were made on day four, after the Earth had formed on day three. The universe is one gigantic interconnected electric sea ... and God said, "Let there be light: and there was light."

No man will ever know all the creative details, nor could they comprehend it, as God brought space, mass (waters), and light into existence from nothing. But there are measurable and verifiable experiments that explain a few of the details once these ingredients were created. Based on scientific fact, six twenty-four hour days was more than enough time. "Where God placed water" ... that phrase from Matt's sermons takes on an even deeper meaning to me.
