A Note From the Elders . . . Looking for a Preacher

Romans 10:15 " . . . How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things"

The elders have asked seven of your fellow members to help us with the initial few steps in identifying the man best suited to be our next preacher. This group will examine and research the information provided by each applicant to formulate an initial assessment and provide the eldership consistent information based on structured questions and criteria.

There are two primary reasons we have decided to use this method. First, it allows early representative involvement of the congregation through this group of our members. The members were chosen as a diverse group, representing various demographic elements of the Woodstock church family. Second, this method promises to be more efficient than other ways we have employed in the past and has been shown to work very well for other congregations.

The eldership will then determine which men we will invite to be interviewed in-person and possibly deliver a sermon and lead a Bible class. At this point in the process, the entire congregation will be directly involved by providing written feedback similar to that we have used in the past. This feedback is the most valuable component of the process.

The members in this group are Gary Kyle, Johnny Mackey, Ron Dunnivant, Barbara Murphy, Jeremy Powell, Shirley Walters, and Rick Laukka. We have asked these people to be open to members suggesting potential candidates. However, to protect applicants, we have asked them refrain from sharing the names of men they are researching.

The elders are praying and anticipate this process will move forward smoothly and at a reasonable pace. Please keep this matter in your prayers as well.
