A Note From Bryan. . . Count Your Blessings

Count Your Blessings is a song that most of you know well. In our song book it is song number 118. It is a song that we sing often and the words to the song indicate that when we are struggling through life we need to count the many blessings that we receive from God. Counting our blessings is a way for us to approach life with a more positive outlook. Counting our blessings is something that we talk about in conversations as well.

Driving in to work this week I began thinking about blessings and how we think of blessings. As I mentioned above counting our blessings is one thing we do with blessings. We enumerate the positive things in our lives that we consider to be gifts from God. Blessings are something we ask for too. We want God to continue raining down those gifts from heaven. We want God to guide us in the right path, clear the pathway from time to time, put the right people and situations across our paths.

We say a blessing when it is meal time. In 1 Timothy 4:4, 5 Paul stated, "For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; for it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer." There are a few different ways that we use the term blessing and rightly so. But when we ask for blessings are we not also seeking blessings of approval?

The thoughts I was referring to during my daily commute are those that have the connotation of "the divine nod." We pray for God to be in our life and to guide us in making crucial life decisions. We pray for God's will to be done in showing us the right way to go. In essence when we pray, "your will be done" are we not seeking the approval of God for our actions? If not, I believe we should. The reason I am sharing this thought with you is that I have not always approached prayer in this way at least consciously aware that in asking for God's will to be done that I was asking for God's approval.

When a young man wants to marry a certain young woman it is customary in our culture for the young man to embark on the most nerve racking exchange of his life. A conscientious young man feels compelled to ask the young lady's father for his blessing. When we talk to God about the things that matter most I believe it is helpful to all of us to see God's blessing as asking for God's approval of those matters. As the scriptures teach us we must be constant in our prayers seeking God's guidance and approval for our life's endeavors.
