### A Note From Bryan... Are You Coachable?

It appears that many people are eager to learn but don't necessarily want to be directed in learning by someone else. No one likes being corrected or told what to do even when it is in their best interest. The Proverbs are filled with verses that tell us to listen to instruction; that it is the wisest thing to do in order to be successful.

In Matthew 26, after Jesus had finished the Olivet discourse, He went to Simon's house in the town of Bethany where an unnamed woman anointed His head with fragrant oil. Matthew wrote that the disciples (not just Judas) were indignant because the oil was expensive and could have been sold for the benefit of the poor. Jesus disagreed and told the disciples that what she'd done for Him was right.

This was an opportunity for Jesus to teach; to correct errors in their thinking. Breaking the bottle of fragrant oil and pouring it on Jesus was a sacrifice for her but Jesus was her priority. While we might pause here and discuss the importance of sacrifice and setting priorities in the Christian's life what happens next with the disciples really bears mentioning even more. The disciple's response to Jesus' correction is indicative of the way mankind responds to Jesus teaching and gentle correction today.

In today's lesson we are going to notice three different reactions to Jesus' teaching. The way the disciples responded when they found they were wrong in their thinking is much the same way people react today when faced with the truth of God's word. Jesus teaching has the power, ability, and authority to shake the foundations your life has been built upon. How do you react or respond when you find out that what Jesus taught is different than what you have always thought or when His word contradicts what you have always been taught to believe?
