A Note From Bryan... Road to Emmaus

Good morning and welcome! We would like to wish you a Happy Easter. It is good to be here this morning to remember the death, burial, and resurrection of our Savior as we do each and every Sunday morning. We are able to meet here this morning to remember because of an empty tomb. It is difficult to fathom how death and burial could be good news, however, they were good news because, without them, there would have been no resurrection.

Paul said in 1 Corinthians 15, of resurrection, "13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen. 14 And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty. 17 And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!" We worship today and remember today because we believe that Christ was raised by the power and the glory of God and that someday we will be with Him because of that empty tomb. This is the indication of verse 24, "Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power."

This morning, in celebration of the Easter holiday, I want to look at a sermon preached by the resurrected Christ found in Luke 24:13ff. After the tomb had been found empty and reported so to the apostles and remaining disciples early on that Sunday morning, two of them were on their way to the village of Emmaus and spoke together of the things that had transpired. Little did they know that the stranger that walked and talked with them was Jesus in the flesh. There is no narrative or script of exactly what He said to them but there is an outline or idea of what He shared with them. That outline is what we will follow today to learn something about what made these men's hearts burn within them.

Visitors' Luncheon

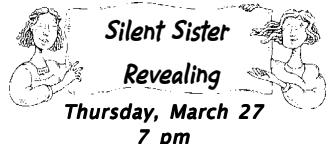

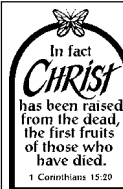
