Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

"THAT'S NOT A SALVATION ISSUE" Part 1

Often in today's religious society when one claiming to be a Christian wants to circumvent a scriptural imperative they will do so by simply stating "that is not a salvation issue" (Who is doing the judging?). Having so opined, they now feel free to ignore the imperative and therefore claim innocence.

For example:
(1) Instrumentalist Statement: "Use of instruments in worship to God is not a salvation issue!"

Scriptural Imperative: Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Colossians 3:16-17).

(2) Denominationalist/Community Church Statement: "Baptism is not a salvation issue!"

Scriptural Imperative: He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned (Mark 16:16). There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ (I Peter 3:21). Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38).

(3) Common Statement and/or Action: Forsaking the assembling (any worship service) is not a salvation issue!

Scriptural Imperative: And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching (Hebrews 10:24-25). But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you (Matthew 6:33).

Any violation of the above scriptures is equal to a transgression of scriptural imperatives (laws); Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness (I John 3:4).

Therefore, according to the above scriptural imperatives, the three (3) statements cited above are invalid, reckless, and without biblical support attesting to the truth that all three (3) indeed are salvation issues! **More next week.**
