A Note From Bryan... In the House of God

We don't come into this world knowing good behavior. We have to learn it somehow. Usually it is by a process of trial and error. You act a certain way and you find out how people receive it. If it's good, very little is said, or maybe some form of praise is offered and voila you learned a right behavior. The opposite is also true; you do the wrong thing and an attentive parent disciplines you. The latter situation is often painful. If you don't learn from attentive parents, society itself will be a teacher, however, a poor one, and the experience of learning outside of a loving home environment can be traumatic.

As we grow older we learn how to behave at home, in school, and, hopefully, in church. Children do not know how to behave in church without being taught by loving parents. But what if the parents don't know? Unfortunately I have several of these scenarios burned in my memory where an angry church member corrected a child and hurt the parent to the point they did not return to the congregation.

While this may seem vague, what we are going to be talking about today is **reverence** and what it means for the Christian to be reverent in worship services. Paul wrote to Timothy, in 1 Timothy 3:14-16, so that he would know how to conduct himself in the house of God. The importance of looking at this passage comes because of the casual nature of our society and the impacts we are seeing in alternative worship styles being offered. However, it is also important to consider for ourselves and the way we approach and behave in worship and what we teach our children about the proper conduct in worship.

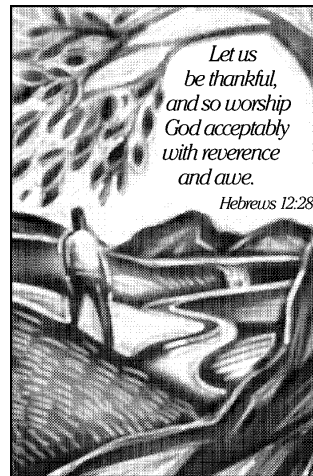
