Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

“THAT’S NOT A SALVATION ISSUE” Part 2

Whether the statement concerns Wednesday/Sunday night attendance or the use of instrumental music as worship, “It’s not a salvation issue” is certainly the wrong statement to make; the wrong thought to have!

First, we need to be more concerned with how we can please God than with what we might get away with. The best driver doesn’t see how close he can come to the edge of the road without falling over the cliff, he sees how far he can stay away from the edge of the road!

Second, the statement misunderstands the condition of salvation. It presupposes people who believe and do everything exactly right, except that they worship with instrumental music. We are not saved because we do everything exactly right! None of us do! I’m glad I’m not saved because I never get a speeding ticket, have a lustful thought, have a bad attitude, fail to pray when I should, fail to help somebody when I should, miss a Sunday/Wednesday night service as I make my flimsy excuse, let my mind dwell on earthly things during the worship of God, etc. we are saved because we are in Christ (Gal. 3:26-27). The condition for remaining in Christ is a mind-set and a life-style! (Rom. 8:1-4; 1 John 1:7). Walking in the light is key to remaining saved! How many times it is possible to remain saved/walking in the light and committing the listed above and other sins, I don’t know and don’t need to know! God knows! But I do know one thing! I must not take any sin and say “It is not a salvation issue!!!” All sins are a salvation issue!

Third, the statement really implies that instrumental music in worship is not really wrong or that bad! It’s not really vain worship. It really doesn’t matter to God that it is an addition to worship. God can really overlook it because I don’t think it’s a big deal. Remember Nadab and Abihu (Lev. 10:1-2)! In New Testament worship, God did not say dance to the Lord, burn incense, pray through a priest, use a trumpet, drums, and harp, make animal sacrifices, as He did under the Old Testament in temple worship. God in the New Testament simply says sing (Col.3:16; Eph. 5:19). Bottom line, it is simply right to do what God wants in the way God says do it. And yes, any sin is a salvation issue!
