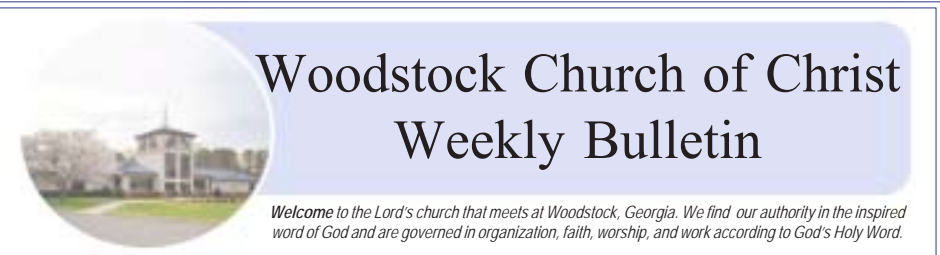

Vol. 25 No. 14 ADVICE FROM THE 1800s April 2, 2017

John William "Dean" Burgon (1813-1888) was a very interesting man of history. He was the Dean of Chichester Cathedral and a very passionate defender of the historicity and Mosaic authorship of Genesis, along with being a staunch defender of overall Biblical inerrancy. Burgon defended the Traditional Text of the NT and proved that pure secular approaches to Biblical texts are flawed. Even though most history records his open debate with the 1888 committee from which the Revised Text was produced (flawed Westcott and Hort text), Burgon left us with some great advice for general study of the scriptures. In his sermons at the Cathedral he taught his Bible students to adhere to the following...

Seven Rules of Bible Study

- 1) Take a half-hour early each day for Bible study
- 2) Read a chapter a day in the Bible
- 3) Go over the passage as if they are new to you
- 4) Avoid commentaries and the like (opinions of men)
- 5) Make a brief memoranda of your own (e.g. table of Patriarchs)
- 6) Read the Bible consecutively from Genesis to Revelation
- 7) Read every book, every word, without skipping any chapters (yes even the name lists)

He also left us with some advice on our attitudes while studying ...

Proper attitudes while Bible reading

- 1) Look for things you may have missed (not known) before
- 2) Always begin with prayer
- 3) Find the honey in the Bible (those things that exhort and correct you)
- 4) Have a mind like Samuel ("speak Lord, for thy servant heareth!")

Even though we disagree with some of his teachings on doctrine, those gems he left us with are definitely good advice for any Bible student. Merely reading the Bible is not enough. The Holy Spirit tells us in 2 Tim 2:15, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." This is direct command from God. The word "study" in the common Greek language of the first century is defined as being "speedily diligent", which in English of today means one should be "marked by preserving, painstaking effort."

How many of us even meet a few of the Rules mentioned above? Maybe we read, but do we read as if studying the topic with painstaking effort? Do we really dig into the meat of the Word of God?

I exhort you brothers and sisters, let us all resolve to do a better job of Bible study on a daily basis. Our heavenly Father demands no less.
