A Note From Bryan... An Invited Guest

Being an invited guest is always a great honor whether it is to be in the presence of a powerful or influential person, a birthday party, or a dinner at a friend's house. It always feels good to know that people think enough of us to invite us.

Jesus told a parable recorded in Luke 14 of a man who planned a get together and invited all his friends and when it was time for dinner no one came. They all had flimsy excuses for not coming and the host was insulted. He told his servants to go out and bring in any stranger that he could get to come because he wanted his house filled with guests. Those who refused the first invitation missed the feast. We understand this to be an eschatological parable indicating that salvation is open to all men and that Christ invites all men to be saved (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9).

In our Bibles, Matthew 11:28-30 is often called, "The Great Invitation." The first twenty-four verses of this chapter tell the story of how John the Baptist was rejected by the people he preached to and how Jesus was subsequently rejected by that same generation of people as well as the cities that were unreceptive to the apostles as they gave the limited commission mentioned in chapter 10. On the heels of this rejection came this great, open-armed invitation. There are three things from this passage that I want us to notice together: the invitation, the instruction, and the inheritance.
