Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

"With What Body Do They Come?"

The Corinthians who did not fully understand the resurrection asked this question in I Corinthians 15:35. First of all, we note that there will indeed be a general resurrection of all the dead (John 5:28), but what will the resurrection body be like? Paul begins to answer this question in I Corinthians 15:36. In Verse 38, he assures us that there will be a resurrection body. He does this same thing in II Corinthians 5:1-4 when he tells us that after our physical body is dissolved we have a "building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens". He says that we will not be found naked, but, rather, will be clothed "with our house which is from heaven." In I Corinthians 15:44, we learn that we shall be resurrected with a "spiritual" body, i.e., one that is unlike the "natural" body that requires sustenance and is given over to disease and death. Earlier, in Verse 39, we are told that there are many different kinds of fleshly bodies: such as that of animals, birds; and fishes. The implication is that the resurrected "spiritual body," will be of a substance unlike any of these or even our present bodies, since flesh and blood cannot enter heaven (Verse 50). But, precisely what kind of body will we have in the resurrection? This, the Bible does not specifically state, but does say (I Corinthians 15:38) that "God gives it a body as He pleases". We learn a little more in Philippians 3:20-21 and I John 3:2: "For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body"; Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

The bottom line answer to the question about the resurrection body is as noted above: "***It has not yet been revealed what we shall be.***" All we are told is that it will be a body like nothing else of which we know and that it shall be like His glorious body. In this, as the children of God, we place our trust and confidence.
