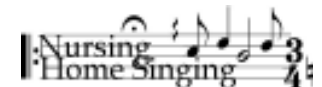

A Note From Bryan...

Peace To You!

When the resurrected Christ appeared to His disciples as they gathered behind closed doors His first words to them were simply, "Peace to you." There was plenty for which to offer them peace. It had been roughly three days since Jesus died. They had put so much hope and trust in Jesus and couldn't believe what had happened. Their lives were upside down and seeing Jesus and hearing these comforting words was just what they needed.

Consider also that they were huddled together behind doors that were closed and locked for fear of the Jews. All they had was each other. Words of peace from the mouth of the resurrected savior was just what they needed at this vulnerable time. Three times Jesus uttered these words in John 20:19-29 which represents two separate but similar occasions.

Peace is a subject that pervades our society but any talk of peace apart from Christ has little or no base for discussion. Most discussions and calls for peace that we hear today are discussions and calls for peace on purely human terms which will never happen apart from the world's one and only savior.

On this Easter Sunday, as we look together into the life of the disciples after they found an empty tomb, consider the need you have for peace in your life and where that peace can be found. Peace in our world will not happen through the efforts of unbelieving diplomats. Peace in our nation will not happen through the efforts of immoral and self-serving elected officials. For these we need to pray (1 Timothy 2:1-4). Peace will not happen at work or at home by your best efforts alone. We need the peace that is offered by Jesus Christ.

It is no coincidence that the first words from Jesus as He rose from the grave were words of peace to His beloved disciples in their time of trouble and deep need. Whatever your need for peace, Christ offers these words to you as we celebrate His resurrection this and every Lord's Day.
