Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.

PLACING MEMBERSHIP?

It has become the practice of some congregations to permit and encourage members of the religious world to simply "place membership" in the Lord's church, based on the baptism that they received in their former religion, even when the reason(s) for that baptism is not according to the scriptures! They do so, however, without regard to our Lord and His Word. It is He who adds men to His church, not men (Acts 2:47). Men do not have the right to receive other men as brethren who have not first been obedient to the Gospel. Jesus said, "I am the Door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture" (John 10:9). All who would enter His sheepfold must do so by Him, which clearly means that it must be only by His authority! Men who try to enter some other way are doomed to failure, according to the words of our Lord: "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the Door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber (John 10:1)

Since the Lord clearly established one church, and only one way to enter that church, it follows that those in the various denominations have not come to "the Door". These are they who "climb up some other way." When men, by their own usurped authority encourage these to simply "place membership" in the Lord's body, they sinfully place their stamp of approval on that which God condemns. Of this, we must never be found guilty!

Whenever there are those claiming membership in the Lord's church on the basis of prior membership in *any* denomination, they need to be lovingly taught God's will and encouraged to enter in by "the Door". Many in this situation will claim, "oh I was baptized correctly". Can one really be taught wrong and baptized right? Do people being baptized by someone truly believe that the person baptizing them is wrong in his teaching? In the second chapter of Acts (vss. 37-47), we find three thousand souls being added to *the* church by the Lord. They were added *only after they were* immersed by His authority *for the remission of sins. Those in Acts 8 were added only after they understood what the kingdom or church was.* These are they who hear His voice and "enter by the Door (John 10:2). To them the Porter opens (John 10:3), but to no other!
