A Note From Bryan...

Grace in Action

Grace in Action...intellectually, most people grasp the fact that one sin is just as bad as another. There are some sins we react more harshly toward than others in a practical way. You might recoil at child abuse and passionately oppose homosexuality and at the same time turn a blind eye to someone skimming the drawer at a fast food place or turn a deaf ear to the foul language of a good friend. Even though we know sin is sin there are some things that we categorize in our minds as having degrees of wrong.

Think of the ways in which we must forgive one another. Are you as forgiving of someone who has an extramarital affair as you are toward someone who has a gambling addiction? Both can be devastating to the families that are involved. Are you as open to forgive someone who commits murder as you are to someone who has held contempt for a brother? Both have the same effect upon the soul of the individual.

Consider the example given in Luke 7:36-50. Simon couldn't believe that Jesus would allow Himself to be touched by a woman so well known for her sin. Jesus spoke a parable to Simon of two debtors forgiven of their debts and Jesus asked Simon which one would love the creditor more. Simon answered the one who was forgiven of more debt which was the answer Jesus expected. Jesus forgave the woman of her sins and it was like being released of a burdensome debt. The question for us to consider is how many times do we rise off our knees pleading for forgiveness only to take the seat of Simon desiring to see others punished for their sins? Every time Jesus had the opportunity to condemn, we find that He responded with grace. Today's lesson looks at several of these examples.
