A Note From Bryan... Don't Sweat the Small Stuff

Remember that little coffee table classic, "Don't Sweat the Small Stuff"? It was one of those like "God's Little Instruction Book" a collection of pithy statements by various people that are supposed to be meaningful and inspiring. My recollections are that the booklet got around to saying that it was all small stuff. Of course, the saying alone is widely known and repeated. While it may be true that most of the "stuff" we are concerned with may be small it isn't always so small to the one who is experiencing it.

I would never think of telling someone suffering from a terminal disease or facing major surgery, "Don't sweat the small stuff." We can all think of some pretty major things that concern us from time to time but, generally speaking, there are a great deal of worries and concerns we have that could be categorized as small stuff. More will be said about this in the lesson this morning.

The Pharisees were a perfect example of those who worried and fussed over the wrong stuff; their priorities were completely out of focus. They focused on petty issues. The Pharisees were highly offended that Jesus did not follow their tradition and did not encourage His disciples to, either. In their minds their tradition had the same authority as the Law itself. As a matter of fact, it had supplanted the Law. The Pharisees, in keeping their tradition, thought they were keeping the Law.

Today we are going to discuss an event in Matthew chapter 12 where the Pharisees were once more focused on all the wrong things. This passage is a good example to us of how we sometimes lose our focus. The hope is to help us reassess our priorities and refocus on what is most important.
