Parents, look around the auditorium. Half of the children you see in the assembly this morning will leave the church and ultimately be lost for eternity! Shocking statistic isn't it. Churches all over the country are losing 50% of the next generation to the world every year. Are your children in that 50% percent that will be lost?? Scary isn't it? They are not faceless statistics; they are the kids we have in Bible class, the ones we take to the bowling alley, rafting, etc. It's tragic! What if I told you there is an insurance policy you can buy that gives your children a 90% chance of being faithful until death and living forever in heaven when this life is over? Would you take a second job to pay for it, or maybe save the vacation money to pay for it, or forgo the eating out we typically do? Would you spend a little more time with them explaining how the policy works? Would you give your very life to gain a policy that would insure your children are in that 90% that makes it to heaven?

I know what you are thinking. Dave is a nut because a policy like that does not exist. I'M HERE TO TELL YOU THAT IT DOES EXIST. You will not have to get a second job or a second mortgage to pay for it either. IT'S ALMOST FREE! Oh, you'll have to sacrifice 30 minutes a day and a few Sunday afternoons to get this policy. I just spent last weekend in Atlanta at the "Lads to Leaders" convention. The statistic that 50% of our children will be lost is true, but there is a way to give them a 90% chance of being faithful and getting to heaven. The current statistic for children who get into the "Lads to Leaders" program and stay in it is part of that 90% that remain faithful and active in the church after they leave home! They learn the Word of God and how to apply its principles in everyday life. They develop relationships with other Christians of all ages. They develop relationships with faithful adult Christians that mentor them and help nurture them as they grow. When they have issues and problems they don't think they can talk to parents about, they talk to faithful Christians with whom they have developed relationships through "Lads to Leaders". Many will find a faithful Christians to marry through association with others in the "Lads to Leaders" program.

Many of Woodstock's children won awards in puppetry. These children will be the Bible class teachers of the future who will be able to apply the Word of God to everyday life though stories children can understand. Many of Woodstock's children won awards in speech and debate. These will be teachers, some elders and deacons, some preachers who will teach and defend the Word of God for the next generation. Woodstock's children won awards in Bible reading and song leading. Some won awards for sermon presentation. As I sat there Sunday morning listening to high school kids preach the Word of God, I wondered if I may be hearing the next preacher who preaches the Word of God every Sunday. I sat in an assembly with over 1000 children knowing that 90% of them would live faithfully unto death and receive the crown of life, AND THEN I CRIED! I cried because we have so many at Woodstock that will not be in that 90% that get to heaven, but will be in the 50% that are lost, forever.

I guess I said all that to say this. PARENTS THIS IS THE BARGAIN OF A LIFETIME!! Thirty minutes here and there and a few Sunday afternoons to have an insurance policy that gives YOUR children a 90% chance of heaven. WHAT COULD BE MORE IMPORTANT THAN THAT!! Jesus said if we gained the whole world but lost our soul, it would profit us nothing. Parents please invest in the bargain of a lifetime, YOUR CHILDREN ARE WORTH EVERY MINUTE!! Please come talk with me. I'd like to have ALL of Woodstock's children in the "Lads to Leaders" program this coming year!!
