### A Note From Bryan. . . The Rest That Remains

Rest, relax, recuperate; all three of these words have almost musical qualities to them and like music they almost create an emotional reaction. We crave rest and peace but stay busy trying to be our best and "get ahead." In 1985 at the age of 14 I had the good fortune to go on a mission trip with my parents to St. Maarten Island in the Caribbean. In the Caribbean, as in other parts of the world, they take a siesta or about an hour break in the heat of the day. I think they may be on to something although I don't think there's much hope of it catching on here in the U.S.

The typical American family has two people bringing in an income. Sadly, the typical American family has to have two incomes to support their lifestyle. Some are required to have the man and the woman working just to make ends meet. After many hours on the job both husband and wife have to come home to more work to do even if they are not bringing their job home which many have to do to keep up. At home there is little time for rest and relaxation because the lawn has to be mowed, the house has to be cleaned, the laundry has to be done, the list is endless. Right after World War II people began to invent "conveniences" that would revolutionize all these mundane time consumers and we would all be free to enjoy more leisure time. It's almost humorous.

In the first ten verses of the fourth chapter of Hebrews it is revealed that there remains a promised rest for you and me. It is this promised rest that we will discuss this morning. You and I have a promised, eternal rest from our labors in heaven. However, this is also a warning not to miss out on that promise like the Israelites did because of disobedience and unfaithfulness.
