A Note From Bryan. . . Build Your House on the Rock

If you grew up going to Sunday School you probably sang a song about the wise man who built his house on the rock and the foolish man who built his house on the sand. In Matthew 7:24-27 Jesus told a parable about two builders; one wise and the other foolish. The wise man indeed built his house on the rock while the foolish man, as the song and the parable state, built his house on the sand. When the winds and the rains came it was only the wise man whose house stood firm.

Television has made it possible for us to observe from a safe distance the horrifying scenes of houses on the West Coast slipping down the sides of the mountains when they get too much rain. The news is quick to show us beach houses swept off their foundations by hurricanes and the aftermath of building on the sand. Still people choose to build pricey homes in prestigious beach communities and perched precariously on cliff tops. These are scenes that are repeated every couple of years when a natural disaster strikes.

The kind of foundation you build your spiritual house upon is crucial to the survivability of your faith. Jesus' intent was to encourage mankind to go the extra mile in preparing a proper foundation for your spiritual life so that you will survive the storms that eventually come along and threaten our spiritual integrity. Men who build their homes on sand are likely to build their entire lives on poor foundations as well. We are going to take a look at some of those poor foundations and compare them with the bedrock foundation Jesus encouraged men to build their lives upon.
