### A Note From Bryan... Spiritual Growth

When a child fails to grow, it doesn't take long for attentive parents to notice and begin to search for answers and solutions. The same is true for a lack of mental development. When a child is physically or mentally ill parents will do just about anything, and pay any price, to treat the illness, in hopes of a complete cure, in order that the afflicted child might live a normal life. Physical ailments are easy to spot. Mental deficiencies are a little bit more difficult to pinpoint. However, a spiritual malady may go completely unnoticed.

Just as God created the world in three spatial dimensions, He created us as multidimensional beings as well. All the complexity of Human beings can be boiled down to the dimensions of mind, body, and soul. We spend a great deal of time working on the mind and body, although experts can't seem to agree about our intellectual limits or our ability to prolong and add quality to life, whether by what and how we learn, or what we eat and how we exercise. There is so much contradictory information about what is healthy for the body and the mind. There is also a lot of false information floating around about what is good for the soul.

Our souls need many of the same things that our minds and bodies need, only in different respects. The soul needs to grow and become strong like the body, but the soul is nourished and strengthened much differently than the body. In this morning's lesson we will discover some of what it takes to grow spiritually in order to recognize the importance of building the spiritual dimension of our lives and realizing how important it is to our eternal existence.
