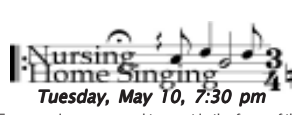

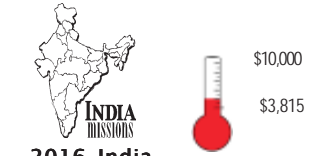

Vol. 24 No. 19 **IS GOD A PERSON LIKE YOU AND ME?** May 8, 2016

Exodus 33:11: "And the Lord spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to a friend."

God is not like you and me in the sense that He is not a physical being as we are. This fact is made completely clear throughout the Bible. First, God makes a definite distinction between deity and humans in Hosea 11:9, where He says, "For I am God, and not man." Second, in John 4:24, we are told by our Lord that "God is a spirit." Well then, what does Exodus 33 teach us? We can see from the above two scriptures that Bible is not teaching that God has a physical face as Moses had! If one were to conclude that God was a human being, because He is said to have a face, in order to be consistent one would also have to say that God was a bird based on Psalms 91:4, where it is stated that, "He will cover you with His feathers and under His wings you will trust." The use of such physical things, such as "face, feathers, and wings," to describe God, or an action God may take, is a figure of speech known as "anthropomorphism." To attribute a human face or body to God makes Him no more human than it makes a clock human when we attribute to it a face! In our subject verse when the Bible says that the Lord spoke to Moses face to face, it simply implies that He spoke to Moses directly, positively, and forthrightly as one would to a friend! In addition to this our conclusion is further evidenced by what John wrote in 1 John 4:12, "No man has seen God at any time." Also, later in our subject chapter we find Moses speaking to God and saying, "I beg you, show me your glory." God's reply to Moses' request is found in Exodus 33:20, "You cannot not see my face; for no man will see me and live." To say then, that Exodus 33:11 teaches that Moses actually and physically talked face to face with God is to contradict these clear passages presented above, as well as the immediate context of Exodus, chapter thirty-three.

In Verse 18, Moses had requested of God that He would show him His glory. God then responded to Moses, "I will not show you my face, but you will see my back parts". God, as a Spirit, does not have a physical face, back, or body. Moses, then did not see any physical features of God, but rather, in some miraculous fashion, by responding to Moses' request that he might see the glory of God, He showed Moses a manifestation of His glory or an appearance that represented that glory! Clearly, God, in some way, showed Moses some symbolic representation of a part of His glory and not a "physical back" as though He was reduced to bearing actual human features. That would not happen until He would appear in the flesh as recorded in John 1:14!

Questions such as these are not difficult when all scripture given on a particular subject are considered and reasonably applied...no contradictions!
