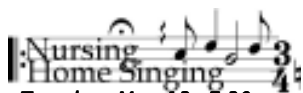
## ESL International Dinner

*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.*

TAKE THE WORLD, BUT GIVE ME JESUS!

In the "Ante-Nicene Fathers," this letter, written to Diognetus in about 130 AD, is found. It describes Christians as they were in that time period: "They dwell in their own countries simply as sojourners.... They are in the flesh, but they do not live after the flesh. They pass their days on earth, but they are citizens of heaven. They obey the prescribed laws, and at the same time, they surpass the laws by their lives. They love all men but are persecuted by all. They are unknown and condemned. They are put to death, but (expect to be) restored to life. They are poor, yet they make many rich. They possess few things; yet, they abound in all. They are dishonored, but in their very dishonor are glorified.... And those who hate them are unable to give any reason for their hatred."

The first Christians clearly lived by a different set of standards than the rest of the world. They had no portion in the world's entertaining practices, honors, and wealth, because they belonged to another King and another kingdom (Colossians 1:13), and they listened to the voice of that King (John 10:27).

That King said, "No one can serve two masters," (Matthew 6:24). However, those claiming to be followers of that King from that time until now have often rejected this axiom. Our manner of life, if we will admit it, often smacks of the notion that we can rightly have both God and the things of this world. We need to periodically ask ourselves the following question: Do I really live my life differently than do non-Christians of the world with high moral standards, other than my weekly attendance to worship? We watch the same entertainment. We clothe ourselves as they do. We share the same concerns about the politics of this world. And we are very often just as much overly involved in the grasping of this world's things! It would appear, then, that being "not of this world" is sometimes more theoretical than real, but not among the faithful who have responded well to the Father's admonition, "Come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty" (2 Corinthians 6:17-18).
