*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### A Note From the Elders . . . PEACE . . . true peace

The word peace is found 389 times in a word search of the NKJV. Peace is one of the elements of the fruit of the spirit. We know this; most of us can recite Galatians 5:22-23 from memory. However, when asked for a definition of peace, the responses cover the preverbal waterfront. *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.* (Gal. 5:22 – 23)

In this world full of conflict, war, stress, and strife there is an eternal positive message: *For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.* (Isaiah 9:6)

This message of peace points to only one person – our savior Jesus Christ.

However, Jesus, when He began his ministry, dropped a stone on his followers when He flatly stated: *"Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword. For I have come to set a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; and a man's enemies will be those of his own household.* (Matt.10:34 - 36)

A casual reader may see a contradiction here. But we must understand that before we can have true, deep, real peace in our lives, there must be a purging of our false gods, a changing of our attitudes, and service to a new Master. Jesus is telling us that this process may very likely cause problems.

When we grasp the notion that true peace may come at a price and we acknowledge that the price we pay is nothing compared to the price Jesus paid, then we begin to cultivate that element of the fruit of the Spirit called peace. This true peace is the result of a promise Jesus made to his followers (and to us) before He left this earth: *Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.* (John 14:26 - 27)
