*Welcome to the Lord's church that meets at Woodstock, Georgia. We find our authority in the inspired word of God and are governed in organization, faith, worship and work according to God's Holy Word.*

### TEMPTATION

The apostle John tells us that "all that is in this world, is the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye, and the pride of life." So, as long as we are in this world, we will be tempted by these things. This does not mean, however, that we must fall into sin as a re-sult of these temptations. James says (1:12-15), "Blessed *is* the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death". But, as the song implies, we don't have to "yield to temptation", because when it does befall us, we can fully rely on Paul's words of 1 Corinthians 10:13; "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*". Jesus Himself "was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin" (Hebrews 4:15), and when tempted by the devil in Matthew, chapter four, He overcame it by using the Word of God. You and I can do the same today as we live according to the Bible, looking for the fulfillment of its precious promises!
