A Note From Bryan. . . Why Repentance?

Words are important. Words have meanings that are connotative and denotative; they have felt meanings and they have actual meanings. It is important to communicate meaning through context; how words are used so that people understand what you are trying to communicate.

Ask anyone you pass on the street the meaning of words like propitiation, sanctification, atonement, or repentance and you would likely get some strange looks. These are words we use in the church. These are words we read in the Bible and they are obscure to people outside the body. At the same time we expect our people to know and understand the meanings of these words.

We assume that everyone who comes through these doors and sits in these pews speaks our language. More importantly we assume that our children are learning our language because they are immersed in it. Since they are attending Bible class and sitting in the worship services we assume that they know the meanings associated with our jargon. Let's not assume too much. Let's make sure that we are actively teaching those around us, especially our children, what these important words mean.

Our children need consistent, repetitious teaching on first principles. No matter how many times I asked the teens what they wanted to study, there was always a question about why we believe certain things that their friends challenge them on; things their friends don't believe. Recently I preached on "Why Baptism" because our children in college want to know and want their peers to know. Since then I have been asked to follow up with "Why Repentance" because we need to be clear, not just for our children, but for people of all ages who need to know.
